About

Minnegoed wines were created specially as an ode to the Flemish family Goeminne, for its love and dedication to South Africa in general and the unique wines produced in this country in particular.

The name Minnegoed is very well chosen. In the Flemish language, the word "beminnen" means to show affection and love (hence: "Minne") and the word "goed" is a double-entendre in this case: it can refer to the good quality of the wine as well as the estate on which it is produced: the Dutch word "wijngoed" is "winery" in English.

The Family Collection features three types of wine. Each name refers to one of the Goeminne children, in which the Sienna range is composed of white wines, the Shelsy range includes the rosé wines and the Milan range features the reds.

Winemaking

Grapes were hand picked in the early hours of the harvesting day from designated vineyard blocks. They were destemmed and crushed before undergoing a controlled cold fermentation in stainless steel tanks. The wine was stabilised, filtered and then bottled into a lightweight, 350g bottle.

Analysis

Alc: 12.29 vol% RS: 4.6g/L pH: 3.40 TA: 5.84g/L

Winemaker's Comments

A fresh, delicate wine with fruity aromas. Well balanced with exotic guava, citrus and passion fruit culminating in a crisp lingering finish.
