story

It is a rather special story of an old vineyard in Stellenbosch. Cinsault planted in 1953, by absolute chance, now 65 odd years later, we are cultivating and harvesting this piece of history and producing a very special stand-alone wine. Only 1170 bottles produced.

in the vineyard

Located in the magical Bottelary Hills, this vineyard stands firm and tall as one of the oldest vineyards in Stellenbosch. Planted in rich soils with weathered granite and shale, fully exposed to the African sun, allowing this admirably adapted variety to flourish.

tasting

It is a charming and eloquent expression of the variety. Nose shows cranberry and red cherry notes, with a floral element that is underpinned by fragrant spices. It is light of touch on the palate but remains concentrated with bright acidity and powdery tannins, giving length to the dry finish.

ageing potential Drinks exceptionally well now. Will benefit from cellaring for another 6 – 8 years
