PINOT NOIR ROSÉ 2021

- Winemaker – Nico Grobler
- Varietals – 100% Pinot Noir
- Origin – Elgin Valley
- Clone – PN B52
- Age of vines – 13 years
- Soil – Bokkeveld shale.
- Planting density – ranging from 3 300 vines/ Ha
- Elevation – 350 metres above sea level
- Yield – 10 Tons/ Ha
- Vinification – Picked at MCC ripeness to preserve the natural acidity and red strawberry fruit. Destemmed and crushed with an immediate soft pressing to ensure very little tannin and colour. Spontaneously fermented in stainless steel tanks at a temperature of 12 - 14°C.
- Aging - 2 months on the lees to allow the wine some time to settle.
- Winemakers Notes – Fresh strawberries and Rose petals with a clean dry, crisp red fruit driven finish.
- Production – 600 cases x 6
- Technical Analysis – Alc. 12.0% | TA – 6.5g/L | pH – 3.38 | RS – 1.8g/L
