

**The Syrah 2019 is made from grapes grown on both of our farms, the perfect example of how fruit from two different terroirs can harmonize to create a beautiful wine showcasing the best of both regions.**

## Winemakers Notes

The grapes were harvested at optimal ripeness and fermented in stainless steel tanks. The Elgin and Simonsberg components were vinified separately. Pump overs were done 3 times a day to ensure colour and tannin extraction. The wine spent 16 months in French oak barrels and was bottled under stelvin and cork closure.

## Tasting Notes

"This wine is carefully handcrafted so as to produce a massively pleasing burst on the palate. It's soft and supple with polished tannins. Full bodied and generous yet elegant too. Maybe a hint of smoky bacon crossed my nose? But that savouriness is backed up quickly by ripe and delicious red fruit and then.... just a sprinkling of fine white pepper on the end. Perfect."
