



The Syrah 2019 is made from grapes grown on both of our farms, the perfect example of how fruit from two different terroirs can harmonize to create a beautiful wine showcasing the best of both regions.

Winemakers Notes

The grapes were harvested at optimal ripeness and fermented in stainless steel tanks. The Elgin and Simonsberg components were vinified separately. Pump overs were done 3 times a day to ensure colour and tannin extraction. The wine spent 16 months in French oak barrels and was bottled under stelvin and cork closure.

Tasting Notes

"This wine is carefully handcrafted so as to produce a massively pleasing burst on the palate. It's soft and supple with polished tannins. Full bodied and generous yet elegant too. Maybe a hint of smoky bacon crossed my nose? But that savouriness is backed up quickly by ripe and delicious red fruit and then.... just a sprinkling of fine white pepper on the end. Perfect."
